

Navigator Grant Recipients in the Addiction Field:

Florida:

Mental Health America (MHA) – Anticipated*¹ grant amount: \$683,691

MHA is an advocacy organization that addresses a broad spectrum of mental and substance use conditions and their effects nationwide.

Indiana:

Affiliated Service Providers of Indiana, Inc. (ASPIN) – Anticipated grant amount: \$897,150
ASPIN is non-profit behavioral health provider and education network. The ASPIN Behavioral Health Clinical Network maintains CARF accreditation under the Business and Services Management Network accreditation standards. The Behavioral Health Clinical Network is also a certified Managed Care Provider (MCP) for the State of Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction.

North Carolina:

Alcohol/Drug Council of North Carolina (ADCNC) – Anticipated grant amount: \$324,798
ADCNC is an organization that provides advocacy, information, referral services, and public education for the state in the field of substance abuse.

North Dakota:

Minot State University – North Dakota Center for Persons with Disabilities (NDCPD) – Anticipated grant amount: \$414,000
NDCPD serves a community of people with mild disabilities, mental health disorders, farmers, young adults, Native Americans, small businesses, unemployed, and those with drug or alcohol addiction.

Ohio:

Clermont Recovery Center, Inc. (CRC) – Anticipated grant amount: \$44,938
CRC is a not-for-profit drug and alcohol outpatient treatment and prevention agency.

Pennsylvania:

Mental Health America (MHA) – Anticipated* grant amount: \$503,129

MHA is an advocacy organization that addresses a broad spectrum of mental and substance use conditions and their effects nationwide.

Pennsylvania Mental Health Consumers' Association (PMHCA) – Anticipated grant amount: \$380,000
